YouGov interviewed adults aged 18+ general population in Denmark(1063), Italy(1124), Lithuania(1051), Romania(1077), South Korea(1064) and adults aged 18+ Internet users populations in Colombia(1135), Taiwan(1069). The respondents from each country were then matched down to a sample of 1000 to produce the final dataset. The respondents were matched to a general population sampling frame(internet users sampling frame for Colombia and Taiwan) on gender, age and education.

The frame was constructed from the following source:
Colombia, Taiwan: general population frame and internet users frame are from the same frame source.

South Korea – Pew 2019
Colombia – LAPOP 2021
Denmark, Italy, Lithuania, Romania – Eurobarometer 2022
Taiwan – Asian Barometer Survey Wave 5

The matched cases from each country were weighted to the general population sampling frame using propensity scores. The matched cases and the frame were combined and a logistic regression was estimated for inclusion in the frame. The propensity score function included age, gender and education. The propensity scores were grouped into deciles of the estimated propensity score in the frame and post-stratified according to these deciles.

The weights for each country were then post-stratified on turnout, vote choice, gender, age, and education to the general population sampling frame. The final weights were produced for Denmark, Italy, Lithuania, Romania and South Korea.

For Colombia and Taiwan, the weights for each country were then post-stratified on gender, age, and education to internet users sampling frame to produce the final weights.
