In recent years, political dialogue has been used effectively to prevent crises during hotly contested elections and popular consultations. Negotiated agreements on fair play, often in the form of voluntary codes of conduct, contributed to preventing simmering tensions from escalating during electoral processes, and to establishing a culture of democratic dialogue. The Facilitator's Guide is published by International IDEA and the Swiss Federal Department of Foreign Affairs, and includes examples from Peru (2005-2015), Ghana (2012), Tunisia (2014), Myanmar (2015) and Georgia (2016).


The panellists will share experiences and address related issues such as:
