Election Date: 7 February 2024

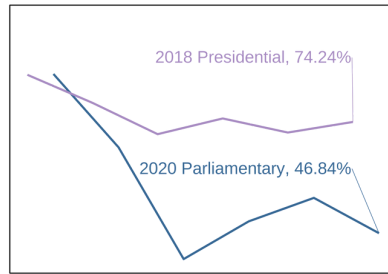
Incumbent Head of State: President Ilham Aliyev

Incumbent Head of Government: Prime Minister Ali Asadov (since 2019)

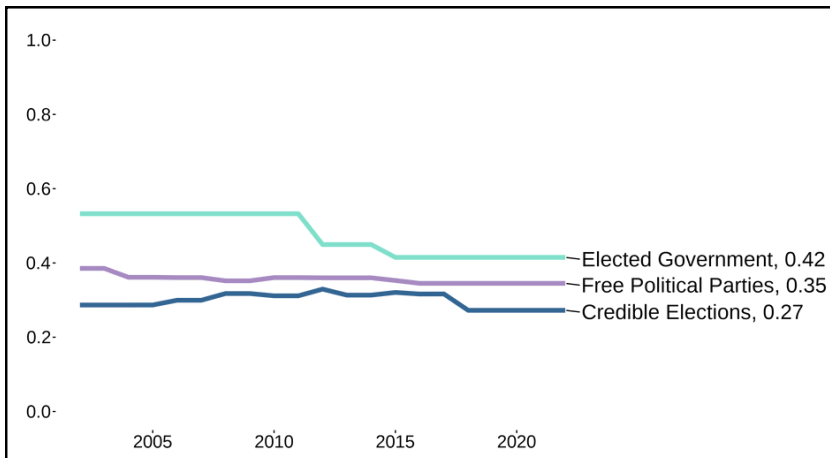
