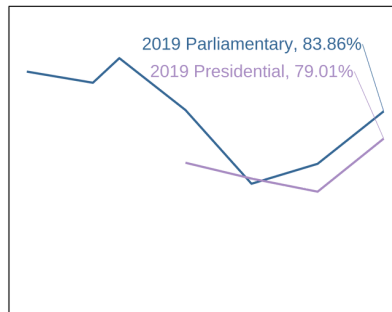

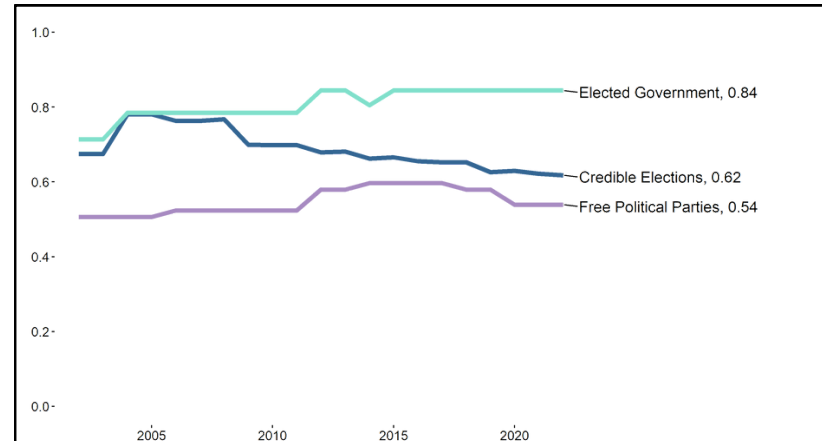

Selection Process for Head of State:
Direct election (two-round majority, with minimum regional distribution of vote needed to win first round)
