Section 1.

1. General Information:

- 1.1. The International Institute for Democracy and Electoral Assistance (International IDEA) is an intergovernmental organization established in 1995, with Member States across all continents, which aims to support sustainable democracy world-wide and assist in the development of institutions and the culture of democracy. At the interface between research, fieldwork and the donor community, IDEA provides a forum for dialogue, builds networks of experts, develops training materials, and provides strategic advice at international, regional and national level, cooperating with a range of organizations. The Institute, which is funded, inter alia, by the European Union (EU), implements projects in Nigeria, at the federal level and currently in 7 states Abia, Adamawa, Anambra, Edo, Kano, Lagos and Plateau. Additional states may be added in future.
- 1.2. We now seek expressions of interest from qualified individuals/organisations to add to a roster of Service Providers for Construction and Renovation Works for Nigeria Operations from which we may call off services as required. Inclusion in the roster is not a guarantee that you will be contracted for any work. Each piece of work will have terms of reference drafted which will include expected deliverables and an anticipated timeframe for delivery. If your skills match the requirements, you will then be requested to confirm your availability and provide a quotation for the work required. Several pre-qualified service providers may be approached to provide quotations for each piece of work. If agreement is reached, a contract will be entered into for that work.
- 1.3. The services include construction and renovation works, as well as other related tasks below in support of Nigeria operations, but is not limited to:
 - 1.3.1.1. Building construction (new structures)
 - 1.3.1.2. Renovation and refurbishment of existing facilities
 - 1.3.1.3. Electrical and plumbing installations
 - 1.3.1.4. Structural repairs and finishing works.

A detailed description of the assignment is provided in the Terms of Reference attached.
